

VALUE SET AT \$385,355

STRATFORD WILL IS FILED IN PROBATE COURT.

Assets Include Shares in the Engineering Company He Founded.

An inventory and appraisal filed yesterday in the Jackson County Probate court showed that the value of the estate of Charles Walcott Stratford was \$385,355, principally in corporate stocks.

Stratford, founder, president and chairman of the board of Stratford Engineering company, died January 24 at the age of 85. The home is at 6201 Ward parkway.

Stock Is Included.

Included in the assets are 3,421 shares of common stock in the engineering company.

In his will, dated October 19, 1961, he leaves \$1 to each of three daughters. They are Mrs. Mary Pinault, New York; Mrs. Charlotte Weeks, Raleigh, N. C., and Mrs. Georgette Lear, Galliac Tara, France.

Dr. Walter P. Jacob, 1002 Romany road, the family doctor, received \$20,000.

Trust Fund Set Up.

The rest is to be placed in a trust fund for the benefit of the widow, Mrs. Audrey W.

Stratford of the home. She is to receive most of the income and principal.

Payments of \$50 a month are to be made from the trust fund to Mrs. Berta Riley of Oklahoma City. She is Mrs. Stratford's aunt.

The Union National bank was named trustee of the fund and executor of the will.
