

Greek 'Naval Hero' Revealed Phoney

BEVERLY HILLS, Jan. 13 (A.P.) —Disclosure that a suave uniformed man, who allegedly gave his name as Lt. Comdr. Aristotle Zison Nyad, 28, claimed himself a Greek naval hero, and for three months was entertained lavishly in society, actually is an imposter named Aris Notaris was made today by Police Capt. W. W. White.

White, who booked Notaras for immigration authorities, said records show the prisoner first was apprehended after entering the country illegally in New York in November, 1941, and was deported to Canada under proviso he join the Canadian army.
