

De Nijs Outlasts

Pros For Win

OHRID, Yugoslavia (AP) — Judith De Nijs of Holland, a 23-year-old mother, outlasted a number of prominent professional distance swimmers Monday and won a 21½-mile race called The World Championships in Marathon Swimming on Fresh Waters.

Mrs. De Nijs covered the distance despite waves up to three feet high in 12 hours, eight minutes, five seconds. Mahmoud Hanafi of the United Arab Republic finished second and Diki Bojadzi of Yugoslavia third.

THE ROUGH water forced many of the 21 starters to drop out.
