Second Jellyfish Sting

Steve Munatones, official Open Water swimming observer, on board Voyager reports Diana is swimming again after being stopped by a second jellyfish sting, this time on the lips; the type has been identified provisionally as Oleandrus. Pain from the first sting on the neck from the 8:40pm hit rated as a 3 out of 10; pain from this second, a 7. With Diana treading water, the second sting required 4 minutes and 39 seconds for treatment.

The swimmer has traveled 9.89 miles with 93 miles to go. Her swimming is now back to 50 strokes per minute. An hour ago, Steve also reported, "An ongoing one-foot chop is against her as it has been for the last several hours."

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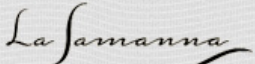
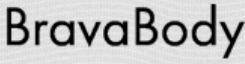
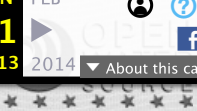
