If all weather signs and conditions hold true, Diana Nyad will leap into the waters off the Havana shore at 7a.m. on Sunday. Diana already holds the record for the farthest unaided openwater swim in history (from the Bahamas to Florida). This upcoming 103-mile swim will require at least 60 hours of continuous nonstop effort.

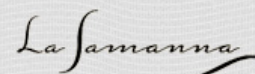
