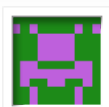

Swimming would never have become the joy in my life it is had it not been for Diana offering the generosity of her genius coaching to a total novice (me). She still takes the time to give pointers to my friend Le Anne and me in upstate NY, taking a look at our strokes, which she did less than a week after that

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29-hour swim featured in the CNN documentary. Some nice folks who live on Upper Rhoda Pond gave us the use of their dock for some wind-down swims in freshwater. Diana wasn't even sore after swimming halfway from Cuba to Florida! She's struggled with allergies all her life but never in the water, till this time. We think it might have been an over the counter painkiller—a generic packaged in another country with nitrites as a filler—that provoked the ashtma attack, exacerbated by tiny jellyfish stings, all over her body. But who can say. It's so unfortunate that after thousands of miles of training a medical issue would end the swim. Yet it's a larger good fortune—and her wisdom in finally respecting her body's duress—that we have to thank for her still being with us.
